David Woolfolk, II, 45, became the first recipient of a scholarship established by *iCare* to help people with disabilities attend the Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC). Woolfolk was recognized during the MATC Partners in Excellence Scholarship Recognition Dinner, held at the Italian Community Center on March 30.

Woolfolk is a second year student at MATC and is currently enrolled in the Baking Production Pastry Arts program. He received a one-year, \$2500 scholarship from the MATC/*iCare* Scholarship Fund, which will go toward his tuition.

Originally from Kentucky, Woolfolk moved to Milwaukee in 1999. He participates in work/study at MATC, where he trains students on running the school bakery at night.

“I want to thank *iCare* for helping me to go forward with my dream, which is to travel abroad and become a pastry chef or own a business,” stated Woolfolk.
